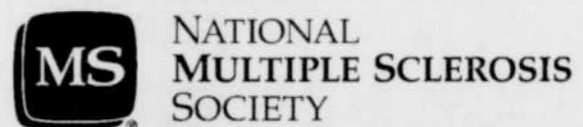
A memorial service and dinner will be held on August 26th at 2 p.m. at the Port of Morrow Riverfront facility. Everyone is welcome to attend.
