

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

-MCSO received a report of a disturbance between two females outside the caller's residence in Boardman.

-MCSO received a report of an audible alarm at the Ione Market. All appeared okay.

-MCSO received a report from a subject in Boardman that his neighbor's car alarm had been set off by high winds and had been set off. An officer was able to locate someone with keys.

-MCSO, Boardman Police Dept. received a report from the Boardman Texaco that three juveniles behind the store were being destructive and refusing to leave.

-MCSO received a report of a suspicious subject at A.C. Houghton Elementary School in Irrigon. A deputy was unable to locate the person.
