

### Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

-MCSO received a report of a sign stolen in Lexington.

-MCSO received several reports of two loud booms heard. It was sonic booms caused by military jets flying low over the area.

-MCSO received a request for deputy contact near the Columbia River past the MCGG elevator off Patterson Ferry Road in Irrigon for two intoxicated subjects who were "gillnetting" and had overturned their boats.

-MCSO received a report from Bank of Eastern Oregon in Irrigon that a deposit envelope was located that a customer misplaced when they made their deposit in the night drop. The envelope was open and money removed but a check was left. The envelope was rolled up and hidden in the night drop box.

-MCSO received a report of an alarm accidentally set off in Boardman.

-MCSO received a report of smoke near Finley Butte/Bombing Range. The caller called back and said it looked like a controlled burn. There were people and equipment near it.
