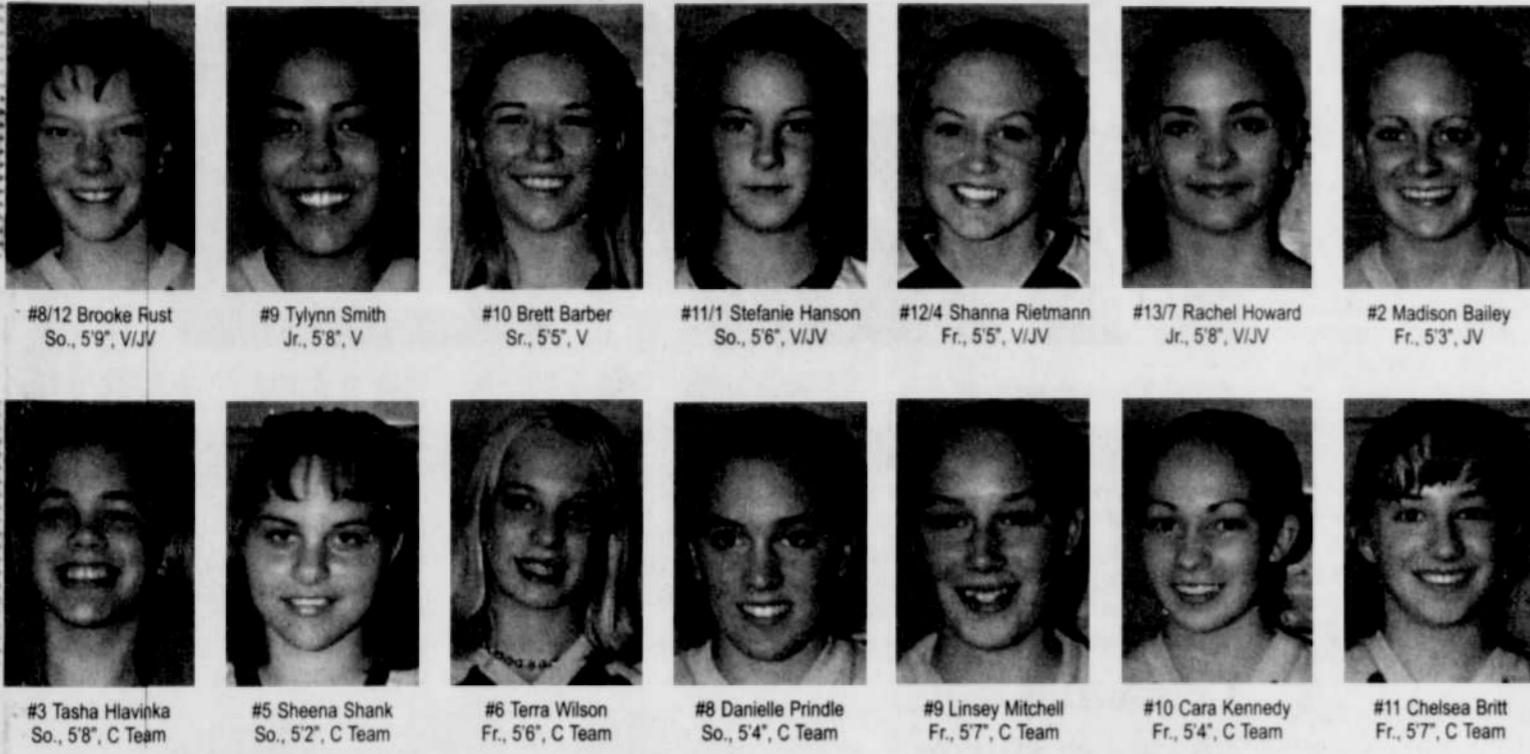

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

-MCSO received a request for deputy contact in Boardman regarding questions on a restraining order.

-MCSO received a report from Irrigon of a possible domestic situation. A male subject in a vehicle appeared to be abusing a female.
