## Mustang girls fall to Condon

Too many trips to the free throw line by the Condon Blue Devils spelled defeat for the visiting Heppner Mustangs as they fell, 63-47, in the first game of the season for both teams. The Blue Devils hit 25 of 38 free throws to the Mustangs' 10 of 14 to help them get the win.

The game was put together at the last minute as snowy roads kept Elgin from traveling to Condon and Heppner from getting to Joseph. The Mustangs host Joseph on Friday, Dec. 7, in their next action.

Meghan Bailey and Jesse Kempas each hit three-pointers in the first as the Mustangs trailed 14-12 after one and eventually took a 19-16 lead on another three-pointer by Kempas. Bailey hit a second three-pointer to make it 22-20, but the Blue Devils went on a 7-0 run to end the half with a 27-22 lead.

Shelley Rietmann scored on a pass from Lacey Matteson to open the third quarter, but the Blue Devils scored four straight before Tylynn Smith scored on a rebound. Kempas converted a three-point play to cut the lead to 35-31, but the Blue Devils went on another 7-0 run to end the quarter and take a 42-31 lead.

The Blue Devils increased their lead to 52-34 before Matteson hit

a jumper and Kempas scored on a pass from Shanna Rietmann to make it 54-38. Matteson hit two free throws and a three-pointer to make it 59-43. Shelley Rietmann hit two free throws and Jodie Carlson scored at the buzzer to make the final 63-47.

The Blue Devils hit 17 of 20 free throws in the second half to keep the Mustangs from cutting into their lead.

Shelley Rietmann scored 14 points and grabbed five rebounds. Kempas scored 13 points and grabbed three rebounds. Matteson scored eight points, had five assists, four rebounds and two steals.

In limited time due to foul trouble, Bailey scored six points and Brett Barber had three assists and three steals.

Carlson and Smith each had three rebounds and Shanna Rietmann had three assists.
