

## Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

-MCSO received a report from a caller that a vehicle hit a deer on Highway 730. It was a non-injury, non-blocking accident; a tow was requested.

-MCSO received a hang-up 911 call from Lexington. It was determined all was okay, the phone was in a cooler next to a tree and they were putting in a new hose.
