

## Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

-MCSO, Oregon State Police, Boardman ambulance received a report of a female in her 40s on the Greyhound bus traveling eastbound on I-84 who was having a seizure and was in and out of consciousness. OSP led the bus to Tower Road to meet the ambulance. The bus continued on to Boardman with the ambulance following to assist.

-MCSO received a report of a dispute in Irrigon between the caller and his 19-year-old son.

-MCSO received a report from a caller in Boardman regarding unwanted subjects.

-MCSO received a report from a caller at a residence in Irrigon that a male subject keeps harassing him.
