

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

Jan. 1: MCSO, Oregon State Police received a report from a caller that she heard loud banging noises by her shed. Officers were unable to locate any suspects.

-MCSO deputy cited Salvador Jimenez Toledo, 46, for Driving while License Suspended I, No Insurance. The vehicle was impounded.

-Boardman Police Dept. officer cited Dean Laroy Staten, 36, for DUII (BAC .16), Driving while License Suspended and No Insurance.
