The palace hotel, pictured here in the foreground on the right, was the prominent structure in Heppner in the early 1900's.

Jack Ends of Monument was surely glad to be greeted by this beautiful structure when he arrived in Heppner with his load of wool. This article was written in an early 1900's edition of the Heppner Gazette: Jack Ends came in Monday morning with a six horse team from Monument, loaded with 5500 pounds of wool. Owing to the rain and bad roads the trip was a hard one. Some of the difficulties of freighting can be realized from the fact that Mr. Ends was eight days in making this trip of 55 miles.

The April 26, 1917 edition of the Gazette featured a story about the leasing of the hotel's basement: C.L. Curran of The Dalles, who recently installed a bowling alley in the north room of the Palace Hotel basement, has leased the entire basement floor space, with the exception of one back room, and he will soon put in new billiard and pool tables. Although the billiard and pool room will be separated from the room in which the bowling alleys are situated, the two will be connected by large doors. Both places will be equipped with soft drink fountains and confectionery, cigars and tobacco will be handled.
