

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

-MCSO received a report from a caller in Heppner that someone was in the insurance building shining a flashlight around.

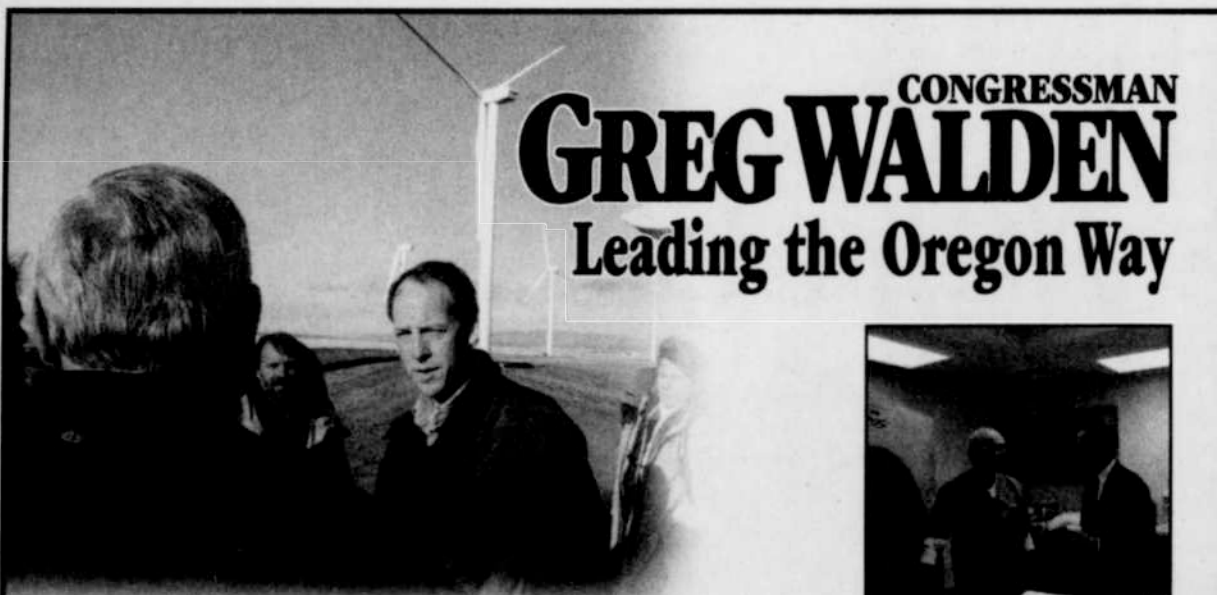
-MCSO, Boardman Police Dept. received a report from a caller that he thought he just witnessed a drug deal in the Sentry parking lot in Boardman.
