

Mustang volleyball team ends season with wins

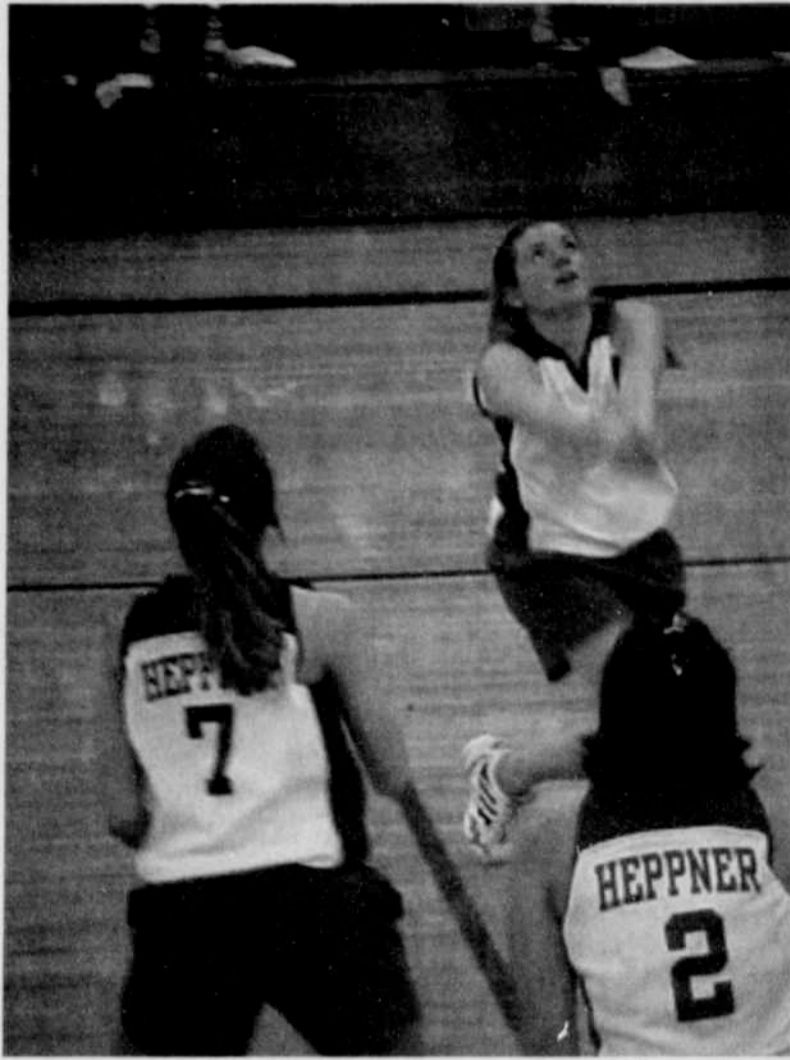

Katherine Margaret "Kay" Burchell, 84, of Corvallis, died Saturday, Oct. 19, 2002, at Park Place Assisted Living.

Burchell was the eldest of five children born to Patrick and Margaret Healy in Heppner and was raised there.

Burchell married Edward Lafayette Burchell in 1935. They lived in Corvallis while her husband completed his studies at Oregon State College, now Oregon State University. She

returned to Heppner during her husband's Army service in World War II. He remained in the service as an officer after the war and the family traveled throughout the United States and the world on his assignments. He retired in 1968 and they moved back to Corvallis in 1971. He died in 1972. Burchell was a homemaker and was remembered as a dedicated mother.

Burchell was a member of the Catholic Church and was church organist during World War II at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Heppner. She had been a Cub Scout den mother, schoolroom mother and catechism teacher. Burchell enjoyed gardening, especially growing roses, and for several years her garden served as a model for a landscaping class at OSU.

Survivors include her daughter, Barbara Ann Burchell of Edinburg, VA; son, Gail Patrick Burchell of Albany; nine grandchildren; 13 great-grandchildren; sister, Pat Gentry of Heppner; and brother, Francis Healy of Portland. Taylor was a member of the bowling league, participated in home extension, Alpha Club, the Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary, Lions, and camping with the Moose Lodge.

She was an active gardener, growing vegetables and flowers. She loved arranging flowers. Taylor was always ready for the opportunity to beat anyone in a game of darts. She recently enjoyed a trip to Alaska with her husband to visit his daughter, Kim.

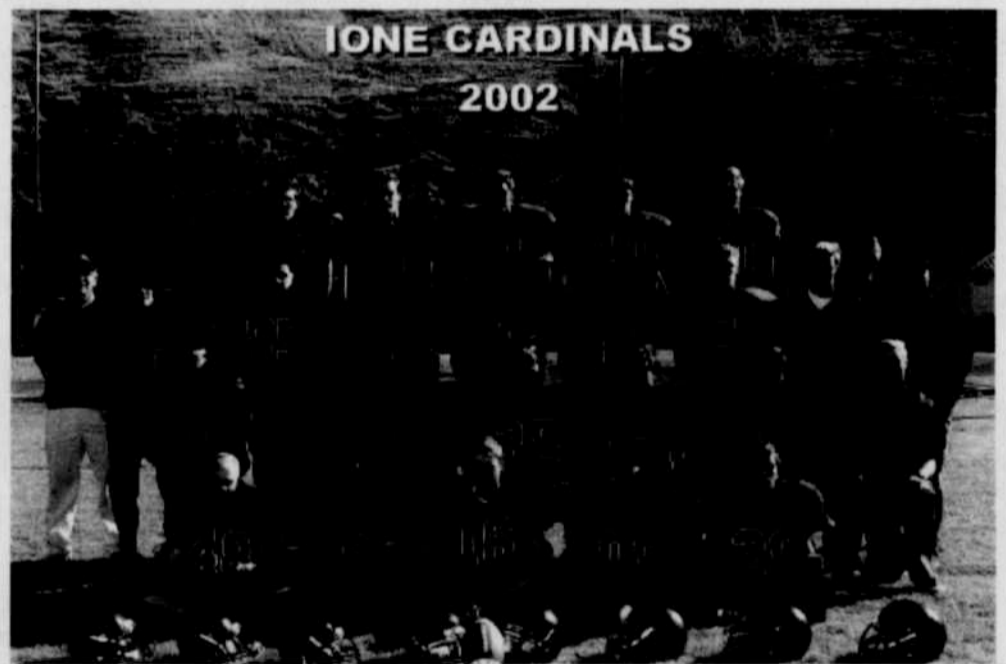
