**Leonid meteor shower viewable on Nov. 19**

Stargazers in the western Americans will have a chance to witness the Leonid meteor shower on early Tuesday morning, Nov. 19.

The shower will send thousands of meteors hurtling into Earth's atmosphere. "Like last year, viewers in the west are going to see a fantastic show, with lots of meteors zipping through the sky," said Jim Todd, Murdock Planetarium manager at the Oregon Museum of Science and Industry.

The Leonid meteor shower occurs every year in mid-November and is composed of debris from periodic Comet Temple-Tuttle, which comes closest to the earth's orbit about every 33.18 years.

This year, Earth will collide with two such clouds on Nov. 18 and Nov. 19. The first cloud will occur on Monday, Nov. 18 at around 8:30 p.m. There will be 500-700 meteors per hour. But on Nov. 19 at around 2:30 a.m., up to 2,000 meteors will be seen.
