

## Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

**Nov. 14:** MCSO received a report from the Corps of Engineers that they were working on an area that would affect the Weather Management Repeater and the flood warning system most of the day. CSEPP was also notified.
