

### Third graders get a lesson in papermaking

Mrs. Osmin's third grade class received a lesson in papermaking from Bill Ewing, a former forestry teacher.

Ewing, who works with the Oregon Women in Timber and the Oregon Forest Resources Institute, travels to NE Oregon schools, teaching children the process of making

homemade paper and the other uses cellulose, the agent that paper is made from, has.

Ewing brings in all the materials: bathroom tissue (to provide cellulose), water bottles, frames, screens, and other items needed, and with the help of the teacher, leads the children in the

process of making paper. After the students go through the process, which takes about two days, because the paper needs to go dry thoroughly, each child has their own piece of paper.

The project gives students a hands-on approach to learning about the timber and paper industries.
