Mustang boys outlast Tigers to take the win

After a tough loss, Friday, Jan. 10, in Weston-McEwen, the Heppner Mustang varsity boys played a much better game in beating the visiting Stanfield Tigers 60-51 on Saturday, Jan. 11 to give new coach Ken Eckman his first varsity win.

The Mustangs evened their Columbia Basin Conference record at 1-1 and improved their overall record to 8-4. Wahtonka will play at Heppner on Friday, Jan. 17 and then the Mustangs go on the road to Culver on Saturday, Jan. 18.

The Mustangs and Tigers started out even as Tanner Britt hit a short jumper and Brad Adams hit a 3-pointer only to be matched by Stanfield. Chuy Elguezabal hit a 3-pointer, Adams drove the baseline for a lay-in and Elguezabal fed Brandon Seitz and Justin Botefuhr for lay-ins as the Mustangs took a 14-5 lead. After a couple Tiger baskets, Brian Smith hit a rebound basket, the Tigers scored again and Luke Murray hit a long jumper to end the first quarter with the Mustangs leading 18-11.

Conor Kilkenny opened the second by hitting one of two free throws and a rebound basket and Murray scored twice to make it 25-13. Adams drove in for a lay-in and converted a three-point play to make it 30-19. Botefuhr hit a jumper, then Adams, Josh Winters and Doug Orwick each hit one of two free throws to end the half with the Mustangs leading 35-21.

Elguezabal scored off a drive, Botefuhr hit a rebound basket, Adams scored off a pass

from Murray who then hit a short jumper and Kilkenny scored off a pass from Adams to make it 45-30. After a Tiger 3-pointer, Kilkenny scored off a rebound and hit one of two free throws; Elguezabal hit a jumper and two free throws after being fouled at the buzzer to give the Mustangs a 52-39 lead after three.

The Tigers went on a 9-2 run to open the fourth to get within six and after Adams scored off a baseline drive, the Tigers converted a three-point play to get within 56-51. Seitz hit one of two free throws with 1:41 left, Winters hit one of two with 55 seconds left and Adams hit two more with 11 seconds left to seal the win.

Adams led the Mustangs with 17 points and 13 rebounds. Elguezabal added 10 points and two assists. Kilkenny had nine points, five rebounds and two steals, while Murray added eight points and Botefuhr had six points and 10 rebounds. Seitz had seven rebounds and Winters had six rebounds and three steals.

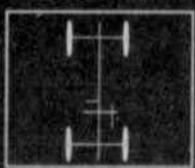

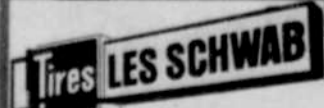
