## Mustang JVs lose to Tigers 19-9

Ten errors, nine walks and eight hits added up to a 19-9 loss by the Heppner Mustang JVs to the Stanfield Tigers on Monday, April 28, in Stanfield. The Mustangs dropped to 8-3 on the year and will play their last game of the year at Pendleton on Thursday, May 8, at 4 p.m.

The Tigers jumped out quick taking a 5-0 lead after one, but the Mustangs came back with two runs in the second when Robert Whalen reached on an error, Kyle Carlson singled and both came home on a Sloan Keithley single.

Eight more runs by the Tigers increased their lead to 13-2. However, the Mustangs came back with four of their

own in the third when Cody Walton reached on an error; Dan Basile reached on a fielder's choice; Trevor Rhea scored two with a single; Ben Turrell singled; Carlson had a RBI single and Keithley was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded to bring in another run.

After the Tigers added another run in the bottom half of the third, the Mustangs scored a run in the fourth when Walton reached on an error and came around to score on a Rhea single.

The Tigers scored two in the bottom half, but the Mustangs came back with two in the top of the fifth when Carlson walked, Keithley reached on an error, Matthew VanCleave had a RBI single and Walton had a RBI single to make it 16-9.

The Tigers scored three in the bottom of the fifth with two outs to end the game on the ten-run rule.

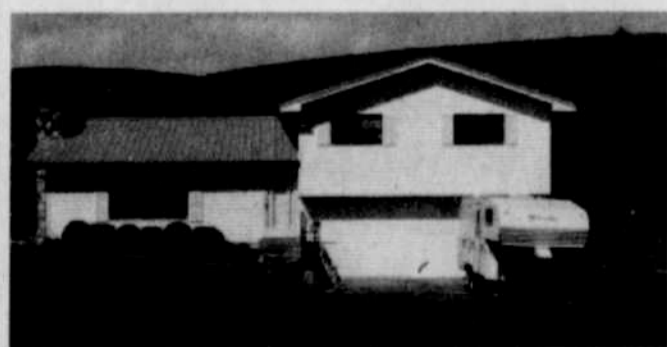
