

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

Swim lessons will begin in July; however, parents can register as soon as the pool opens. Second session lessons will be held July 29-Aug. 8, Tuesdays-Fridays, from 9 a.m.-12 p.m. Each session will cost \$30.
