The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

requesting officer contact regarding some juvenile who had hit the caller's dog and when confronted the kids wanted to fight.

-MCSO received a report of damage to equipment on the Port of Morrow property.


-MCSO received a report from a caller of an assault involving a male subject.

-MCSO deputy cited Christine Fisher, 38, for Exceeding the Maximum Speed Limit, 95 mph in a 65 mph zone.


