

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

March 22: MCSO, Irrigon ambulance received a request for an ambulance from a caller in Irrigon for an 84-year-old female who may have had a stroke. The patient was transported to Good Shepherd Medical Center in Hermiston.
