

## Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

-MCSO received a report from the Umatilla Police Dept. that Hermino Barbosa Vasquez, 45, was arrested on an Irrigon Justice Court warrant for Failure to Pay Fine/Criminal Mischief II.

-MCSO received a report from a caller that his pickup was stolen sometime last night in Irrigon.

-MCSO received a report from the Westwood, CA. sheriff's dept. that a male subject had been arrested in Westwood for selling false amounts of CDs. The subject's car was seized and invoices to Murrays in Condon and Heppner were found for CDs. It was determined the subject targets small towns selling CDs and makes out invoices in his favor by putting a false amount of CDs sold.
