

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

-MCSO received a report from a caller of a vehicle traveling 120 mph. Oregon State Police responded to the report.

-MCSO, Boardman Police Dept. received a report from a caller at Boardman Kegler's Sentry Market, of a possible DUII. Walter A. Hay, 52, was arrested for DUII, and cited for Unlawful Possession of a Firearm and Open Container. The vehicle was impounded.

-MCSO, Oregon State Police received a report from a caller in Irrigon of a vehicle racing up and down the streets. The caller called back and said the vehicle was parked next door.
