

## Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

**May 29:** MCSO, Irrigon ambulance received a report from a caller in Irrigon of a 30-year-old female who had severe abdominal pain. The patient was transported to Good Shepherd Medical Center in Hermiston.

-MCSO, Oregon State Police received a report of a dead deer in the left lane of I-84 westbound. The deer was removed.
