

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

June 3: MCSO received a report from a caller in Boardman that a subject was on her porch and would not leave.

-MCSO cancelled a report on a stole gun.

-MCSO received report that two large dogs were chasing livestock earlier and were now following a female jogger. The caller thought the dog owner was a subject in Boardman.

June 4: MCSO received a report from Umatilla County that Sergio Urrutia Becerra, 41, was arrested on an Irrigon Justice Court warrant for Failure to Pay Fine/Driving while Suspended. Full bail was required and there were also INS holds on him.
