

Sheriff's Report

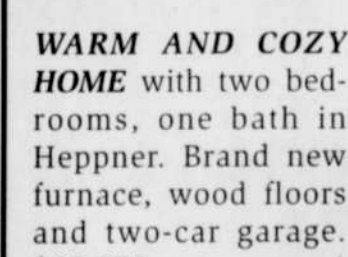

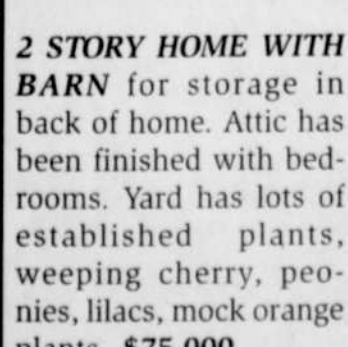
