

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

-MCSO, Oregon State Police received a report of a possible DUI on Highway 730. The vehicle was weaving all over the road.

-MCSO received a report from Baker City Police Dept. that Deborah Sue Lockridge, 46, was arrested on an Irrigon Justice Court warrant for Failure to Pay Fine/Harassment.

-MCSO deputy arrested Chaunsey Lynn Allan, 32, on a Morrow County Circuit Court warrant for Parole Violation/Possession of a Controlled Substance C Felony. Allan was lodged at the Umatilla County Jail.
