

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

-MCSO received a report from a caller in Heppner that a German shepherd was in her yard and she couldn't go outside because she is afraid of the animal.

-MCSO received a request for a background check from the Pendleton and Salem recruiting stations.

-MCSO cited Lois Anne Hibbits, 36, for Theft III.

-MCSO cited Jason Lee Morgan, 28, for Exceeding the Maximum Speed, 85 mph in a 65 mph zone and Unsafe Passing.

-MCSO received a request for contact from a caller in Irrigon regarding his ex-wife removing their children from his residence.
