

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

Aug. 21: MCSO, Boardman Police Dept. received a report from a caller in Boardman of a bald man inside his neighbor's pickup in Boardman.

-MCSO received a report that Superior Auto Recovery repossessed a vehicle in Boardman.

-MCSO, USFS received two reports of smoke coming from the southeast of Black Mountain.

-MCSO received a report from a caller at the Columbia Middle School in Irrigon of two speed control signs stolen.
