

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

Sept. 1: MCSO received a report that a cell phone was missing. The lady later called back and advised she had found the phone.
-MCSO received a report from a caller in Irrigon that two subjects were removing items from another subject's residence. It was determined they had the owner's permission.

-MCSO received a report from LaGrande that a subject was arrested on an Irrigon Justice Court warrant for Failure to Appear/Theft II. The subject was cited and released to appear.
