It was in that Week that he suffered intensely in the Garden of Gethsemane, was kissed by Judas, and healed the ear of Malchus. That was the week in which he was brought before the High Priests, brought to Pilate, and even to Herod. That was the week in which he was scourged, crowned with thorns, and brutally crucified. That was the week in which he prayed for the forgiveness of those who crucified him, promised paradise to the penitent thief, and committed his Mother to the care of St. John. When his work was finished, he exclaimed: "Into Your Hands I commend my spirit."
