

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

March 23: MCSO, Oregon State Police received a report of alarm at Bigfoot Industries in Boardman.

-MCSO, Oregon State Police received a request for assistance from a caller driving a vehicle that was disabled on Highway 730 between Umatilla and Irrigon.

-MCSO deputy advised that he was flagged down by a vehicle en route to Pioneer Memorial Hospital with an elderly male subject; the deputy requested that PMH be contacted and advised.

-MCSO, Oregon State Police, Irrigon Fire Dept. received a report from a caller in Irrigon of a large column of black smoke; the caller thought there was a structure on fire. It was determined a subject was burning tires and was not compliant. OSP responded to the scene.
