

## Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

-MCSO, Boardman Police Dept. received a report from a caller in Boardman of a controlled burn from earlier today was still smoldering and her neighbor saw flames. The caller was unsure if it was still supposed to be burning. A Boardman Police Dept. officer checked and saw smoke only, no flames.

-Boardman Police Dept. officer cited Maura Aguilar Flores, 29, for Violation of the Basic Rule, 36 mph in a 25 mph zone.

**March 30:** MCSO deputy was flagged down by a vehicle on I-84 westbound milepost 159; the deputy followed the vehicle to Boardman, as the vehicle was low on fuel.

-MCSO received a relayed report from Oregon State Police of a vehicle parked for over an hour in front of trees on a dirt road off Patterson Ferry Road. A deputy spoke to security who made contact with the driver and the vehicle was already moved. It was located on Frontage Road.
