Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

April 2: MCSO received a report from a caller in Boardman of a stolen bicycle.

-MCSO received a walk-in request for a deputy contact from a subject in Heppner regarding a neighbor's dogs barking.
