

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

-MCSO received a request for a welfare check on a male subject at his wife's home in Ione. The caller hadn't had any contact from the subject in three weeks and to forward the information to Tri-Comm.

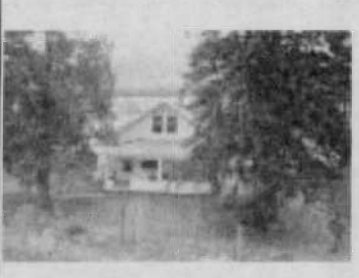

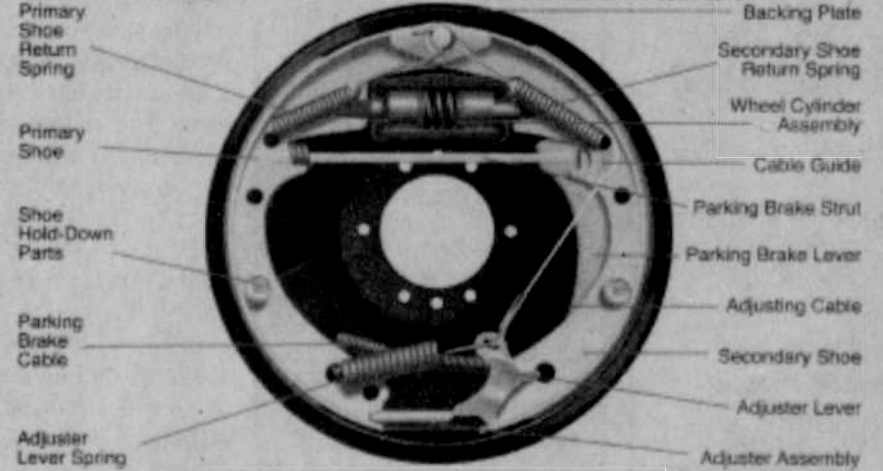

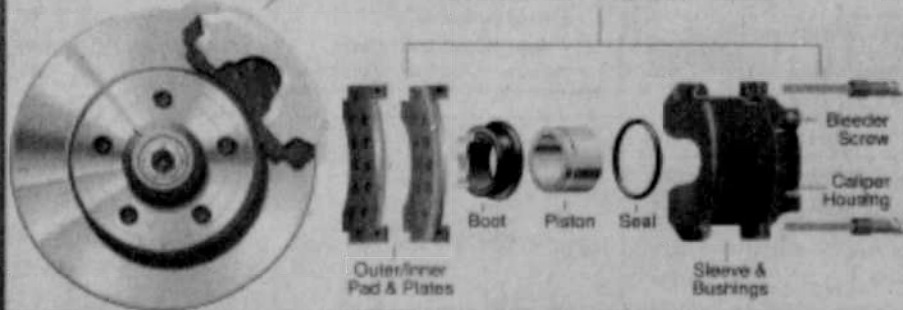
