

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

April 20: MCSO deputies arrested Jorge (Antonio) Cotoc-Sacayon, 32, on several Washington County warrants, and cited for DUII (BAC .25), No Operator's License and No Insurance. He was lodged at the Umatilla County Jail. The vehicle was impounded.
