A group of 26 young people, ages 13 to 18, and five leaders, traveled to Heppner as part of a missions-based program called Target Oregon. Youth throughout Oregon join together and then travel to rural communities to help out local churches and the community. The youth who visited Heppner were from churches in Winston, Junction City and Silverton. Christian Life Center was the host of the

group and with their help was able to put on a 3-on-3 basketball tournament, community picnic and a kids' crusade. The Target Oregon group also did some repair work on the church and volunteered time for community service projects throughout Heppner. Target Oregon is an alternative for youth who are not able to go on international missions. The trip allows for the youth to

gain experience in ministry and service. "These trips allow the kids to get an idea of servant mentality. It gets them use to the idea of service," said Angela Falk, Target Oregon site director from Junction City. The boys stayed at CLC and the girls were housed in homes throughout the community. The Nazarene Church volunteered to house eight of the girls with their members.

Sec. of State announces initiative signature results

Secretary of State Bill Bradbury announced that verification of signatures of seven initiative petitions submitted for the Nov. 2, 2004, General Election ballot have been completed.

For the following constitutional amendments, 100,840 valid signatures were required to gain ballot access.

Initiative #20-Amends Constitution: Limits State Legislators: Six years as representative, eight years as senator, fourteen years in legislature. Initiative #20, with 92,200 valid signatures, did not contain enough valid signatures to qualify to the ballot.

Initiative #106-Amends Constitution: Limits noneconomic damages (defined) recoverable for patient injuries caused by healthcare provider's negligence or recklessness. Initiative #106, with 121,787 valid signatures, contained enough valid signatures to qualify to the ballot.

Initiative #150-Amends Constitution: Only marriage between one man and one woman is valid or legally recognized as marriage. Initiative #150, with 204,160 valid signatures, contained enough valid signatures to

qualify to the ballot.

For the following proposed statutory amendments, 75,630 valid signatures were required to gain ballot access.

Initiative #31-Amends Medical Marijuana Act: Requires marijuana dispensaries for supplying patients/caregivers; raises patients' possession limit. Initiative #31, with 77,872 valid signatures, contained enough valid signatures to qualify to the ballot.

Initiative #36-Government must pay owners, or forgo enforcement, when certain land use restrictions reduce property value. Initiative #36, with 90,276 valid signatures, contained enough valid signatures to qualify to the ballot.

Initiative #90-Abolishes SAIF; state must reinsure, satisfy SAIF's obligations; dedicates proceeds, potential surplus to public purposes. Initiative #90, with 87,479 valid signatures, contained enough valid signatures to qualify to the ballot.

Initiative #120-Requires balancing timber production, resource conservation/preservation in managing state forests; specifically addresses two forests. Initiative #120, with 86,509 valid signatures,

contained enough valid signatures to qualify to the ballot.

The results of all initiative petition signature verifications for the 2004 cycle became final on Aug. 1, 2004, the constitutional deadline for certification of all of the initiatives submitted for the 2004 general election. Measure numbers were assigned after the deadline had passed.
