

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

July 13: MCSO received a report from a caller in Heppner that kids from an apartment took a tire from the back of her car and put it in front of another apartment. A deputy was unable to locate any tire.

-MCSO received a report from a caller in Irrigon that she is receiving harassing phone calls from a female subject.

-MCSO deputy cited a male subject for Violation of the Speed Limit, 84 mph in a 65 mph zone.

-MCSO received a report from a caller of hearing the sound of breaking glass. It was determined to be a broken bottle.

-MCSO received a report from a caller in Irrigon of two subjects fighting across the street. A warning was given.

-MCSO received a request for a deputy contact from a caller in Irrigon regarding a male subject who keeps contacting the caller against her wishes. The male subject was advised not to contact the caller.
