Ruth E. McCabe

Ruth Elizabeth McCabe, 89, of Ione, died Wednesday, March 16, 2005, at her home.

A memorial service will begin at 2 p.m., Saturday, April 2, at Ione United Church of Christ. A private family inurnment service will be at High View Cemetery in Ione.

She was born July 2, 1915, at Lexington, to Arthur and Annie Keene. She grew up on the family's Rhea Creek homestead with her younger brother, Bryce.

The family moved a couple of times, but always returned to the homestead. She attended grade school in one-room school houses,

two on Rhea Creek and one in the Alpine area. Her high school years were spent at Ione and transportation there was a Model T Ford.

On Feb. 22, 1932, she married Lonnie McCabe at Heppner. They had five children.

They lived on the McCabe ranch near Ione, raising grain and a few head of cattle.

Mr. McCabe died March 2, 1974.

McCabe was a homemaker but her activities were numerous. She became a 4-H leader in 1944 and was with the program for about 40 years. She was an excellent seamstress and spent a lot of time at her sewing machine, making everything from clothes to quilts, and was involved with the "Sew it with Wool" contest and the Extension Service for years.

She liked putting in the yard and enjoyed her plants and flowers. She enjoyed working crossword puzzles and liked to travel.

She was an active member of the Historical Society and a supporter of the Ione community.

Survivors include her children and their spouses, Lola Ann and Jim Pettyjohn of Pendleton, Alvin and DeAnna McCabe of Nehalem, Grace and Leland McKinney of Lake Havasu City, AZ, Chris and Pete Devens of East Northport, N.Y., and Doris and Ron Berry of Reno, NV; 18 grandchildren, 31 great-grandchildren, and four great-great-grandchildren.

Ione High School senior girls and their mothers were honored recently by the Ione Topic Club with a noon luncheon. The six girls attending were Amanda Emery, Barbara Holland, Kimberly Morris, Sara Peck, Kasie Peterson and Alyssa Rietmann. The students shared their plans for college attendance next year. They all have been very active in high school activities through the years and plan to pursue careers in the future.

Alex Carlson provided music during the luncheon. Carlson is student at Ione Middle School and has studied violin for eight years. He often shares his musical talent at community activities. Katherine Lindstrom gave a history of the Ione Topic Club, which is celebrating its 75th year as an Ione organization.


The Topic Club was founded in June 1928 by some farm women living on the north side of Ione. This

was during the economic depression and severe drought of the 1930s. The farm women first called their group the North Ione Improvement Society. Members were Vera Rietmann, Elaine Rietmann, Ruth Shane, Beulah Mankin, Sylva Gorgor, Anne Smouse, Leona Christopherson, Blanche Lindstrom and Elsie Gross.

The group met to socialize and review books that they had read. This led to the desire for a town library, which they decided to sponsor in 1933. They have been the sole sponsors of the Ione Library ever since. The group found a home for the library in a number of places during the years. It was housed in the Bill Swanson store for some time and completely destroyed by fire in 1949. The wind blew burning books all over town. The women, not being ones to give up, rebuilt their book supply with help from a

sympathetic and generous public.

The library finally found a permanent home when the Ione City Hall was completed in 1952 and a room was set aside for it at that time. The city continues to assist the library financially each year. Over 200 women have been members of the Topic Club during the years and the library remains a vital part of the town of Ione due to their faithful interest in providing books for the community's education and entertainment.
