

Pie auction raises over \$1200

Thirty pies were entered into this year's 4th annual Pie Contest and Auction. Among the participants were several "Under 16" entries and four residents from Willow Creek Terrace. The residents participating were Irene Swanson, 95, Lowell Gribble, 95 Elmer Meligan, 92 and Verna Brinda, 84. Judges for the contest this year were Nancy Vander Does, Janet McDowell and Debbie Sumner.

The auction brought in \$1245 this year. All proceeds from the auction go to help the Heppner Chamber of Commerce promote and market Heppner and continue holding events throughout the year.

Peggy Fishburn took first place in the adult category with her chocolate butterscotch pie. She won a \$100 gift certificate sponsored by Sherrell Insurance. Kim Bach took second with a rhubarb custard pie. She won a \$50 gift certificate sponsored by Sherrell Insurance. Phyllis Piper took third with a lemon luscious pie. She won a gift basket sponsored by Bank of Eastern Oregon. Ella McCormack took first place in the "Under 16" category with a cranberry freezer pie. She won a \$50 gift certificate sponsored by the Video Store. Whitney Matthews took second with a Kahlua ice cream pie. She won a \$25 cash prize sponsored by Wheatland Insurance.

Three of the winning pie recipes follow:

Chocolate-Butterscotch

Cream Pie

9-inch baked pie shell

First layer- 1 large package cream cheese, softened; 1 cup whipped whipping cream or Cool Whip; 1 cup powdered sugar; and 1 tablespoon finely grated lemon peel.

Beat cream cheese and powdered sugar until smooth and creamy. Add lemon peel. Fold in whipped cream. Spread mixture over crust.

Second layer- 1 1/2 cups milk and 1 package (3.4 ounce) instant butterscotch pudding. Mix according to package directions and spread over cream cheese mixture.

Third layer- 1 1/2 cups milk and 1 package (3.4 ounce) instant chocolate pudding. Mix according to package directions and spread over butterscotch layer.

Fourth layer- Cover top of pie with Cool Whip. Can sprinkle top of pie with ground nuts.

"I used a butterscotch ice cream topping and drizzled across top of the Cool Whip and added chocolate leaves," said Fishburn.

Lemon Luscious Pie

9-inch baked pie shell; 1 cup sugar; 3 tablespoons cornstarch; 1 tablespoon grated lemon peel; 1/4 cup butter; 1/4 cup lemon juice; 1 cup milk; 3 egg yolks, slightly beaten; and 1 cup dairy sour cream.

In sauce pan, combine sugar, cornstarch, lemon peel, butter, lemon juice, milk and egg yolks.

Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly until thick. Cover and cool. Fold in sour cream and pour into baked shell. Chill at least two hours. Before serving, top with whipped cream.

Kahlua Ice Cream Pie

1 (8 1/2 ounce) package chocolate wafers, finely crushed (about 40 wafers); 3 tablespoons granulated sugar; 5 tablespoons butter, melted; 8 ounces cream cheese, softened; 1/4 cup dark rum; 1 quart coffee ice cream, softened; 1 cup heavy cream; 2 tablespoons granulated sugar; 1 to 2 tablespoons Kahlua; and chocolate scrolls.

In a small bowl, combine chocolate crumbs, sugar and butter. Press into a 9-inch round cake pan and chill. In a large bowl, beat cream cheese with rum until light and fluffy. Fold in ice cream. Pour into crust and freeze at least four hours. In a chilled bowl, whip cream, sugar and Kahlua until stiff peaks form. Swirl onto top of pie. Garnish with chocolate scrolls. Freeze at least two hours. Let stand at room temperature about five minutes before serving.

To make chocolate scrolls: Allow squares of

semisweet chocolate to warm slightly. Using a vegetable peeler, peel scrolls from chocolate onto a plate. Refrigerate until firm.
