## OLCC sends funds to Eastern Oregon

Baker, Grant, Harney, Malheur, Morrow, Umatilla, Union, and Wallowa counties and their 52 cities received \$165,016 in the Oregon Liquor Control Commission's September distilled spirits revenue allocation.

Here is the disbursement: Morrow Co., pop. 11,750, \$3,669 - Boardman, \$2,850; Heppner, \$1,297; Ione, \$311; Irrigon, \$1,635; Lexington, \$238.

OLCC revenue is derived from the sale of distilled spirits in 243 liquor stores, taxes on malt beverages and wine, license fees, and fines for liquor law violations. Last month's revenue share was \$10.2 million.

Here are the disbursements: State general fund: \$6.26 million; 239 cities: \$2.24 million; 36 counties: \$1.12 million; City revenue sharing account: \$1.56 million; State Office of Mental Health and Addiction Services: \$672,383; Oregon Wine Board: \$20,626.

The distribution is based on population, with counties receiving 10 percent; cities, 20 percent; state general fund, 56 percent; and city revenue sharing account, 14 percent. The per capita distribution rate for cities was 91 cents; counties 31 cents. The OLCC collects privilege taxes of \$2.60 for a 31-gallon barrel of malt beverage, 67 cents a gallon for taxable wines with an alcohol content of 14 percent or under and 77 cents on taxable wine over 14 percent. Of that, 2 cents a gallon goes to the Oregon Wine Board to fund research and promotional activities.
