**Paraeducator development program gears up**

Morrow County School District recently announced a new paraeducator professional development program to begin in the fall of 2006. Using Federal Title IIA dollars, earmarked for staff development, Morrow County School District will partner with Blue Mountain Community College to promote the development of their paraeducator staff who wish to participate.

Often referred to as a "Grow Your Own Teacher" program, MCSD will help offset the tuition costs for classified staff who wish to pursue a paraeducator certificate, associate of applied sciences degree, or a teaching degree. Classified staff interested in taking part in the program receive paid vouchers from the school district, up to seven credits per term, to be used to take classes that not only will enhance their professional classroom expertise but will also accrue credits toward accomplishing an associates degree or a bachelors in education.

According to Wade Smith, Assistant Superintendent, "this program will promote the professional expertise of all paraeducators who wish to expand their knowledge of their disciplines. We have many talented classified personnel that would make excellent teachers with the proper training, and we are hopeful that this program will help make this possible." Smith also noted that, "Cindy Lenhart, BMCC instructor and Paraeducator Department Chair, has been instrumental in making this program happen." BMCC and Morrow County are hopeful that they will see a strong participation in this program from Morrow County classified staff. If the turnout is high enough, cohorts can be created where classes may be catered to Morrow County locations and times that work with the staff. The program will formally begin during the school district's August in-service where BMCC will meet with interested paraeducators to begin developing their individual educational plans.

The plan was created in response to Senate Bill 1010, which requires the reduction of pollution from agricultural sources. The mission of this plan is to help landowners/operators with sound conservation techniques while maintaining economic and agricultural viability. The plan is designed to help bring local streams and surface water to federal water quality standards. The plan encourages producers to develop voluntary conservation plans, which outline management strategies for addressing water quality concerns. Morrow SWCD can help you develop a conservation plan and also assist in finding funding for your conservation project. Practices recently funded include riparian fencing, offstream water, irrigation efficiency improvements and weed control for improved water quality.

On Jan. 19, 2006, the committee that developed the area agricultural water quality plan met to review it. This committee meets on a biennial basis to discuss accomplishments of the LMA, hear information about local water quality, and update the plan as needed. The committee was pleased with the voluntary projects that have been implemented in the area and was also interested to hear how our water quality and flow monitoring programs may tie into the state's water quality assessment process. A few minor changes were made to the plan to bring it up to date, and it is currently out for review prior to its

approval by the Board of Agriculture. Once it is approved, later this spring, copies will be available at the Oregon Department of Agriculture or on their website, [www.oregon.gov/ODA](http://www.oregon.gov/ODA). All watersheds in Oregon have an adopted AgWQMP.

**Water Quality Program update**

It has been nearly three years since the agricultural water quality plan for our area was finalized and put into place. That document, the "Willow Creek Subbasin Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plan," AgWQMP and associated rules, was adopted in June 2003. The Oregon Administrative Rules have a delayed enforcement date of Jan. 1, 2008 allowing for voluntary compliance. The Morrow SWCD serves as the Local Management Agency (LMA) for the plan, overseeing its implementation. The subbasin area covers all of the area drained by Willow Creek and also includes Sandhollow and the area along the Columbia River between the Willow Creek and Umatilla River watershed boundaries. The purpose of the plan is to identify strategies to reduce water pollution from agricultural lands, in use or idle, through a combination of education programs, suggested land treatments, management activities and monitoring.

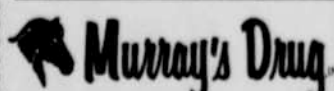
