

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

June 20: MCSO received a report that the Heppner ambulance transported an 89-year-old female subject to Pioneer Memorial Hospital in Heppner.

MCSO received a report from a caller in Ione that a house has been broken into in the last two weeks. The caller stated no one responded to the location the last time a report came into dispatch.

MCSO received a report that Lawrence A. Perrin, 29, was arrested on an Irrigon Justice Court warrant for Failure to Pay Fine/Driving while License Suspended. Perrin was lodged at the Umatilla County Jail.

MCSO received a report from a caller near Boardman of a suspicious vehicle that had been in a location for around six days. The caller had seen the vehicle multiple times.

MCSO received two reports from a caller in Irrigon that dogs are continually barking at a residence; the caller said cages are stacked on top of each other and the dog in the top cage urinates and defecates on the dog in the bottom cage.
