The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

Controlled Substance II. Smith was lodged at the Umatilla County Jail.

MCSO received a report of a vehicle accident on Big Buttercreek Road.

MCSO received a report from a caller in Lone of two pistols stolen from his home; he had been on vacation.

MCSO, Boardman PD received a report from a caller in Boardman that the caller's girlfriend was hitting him and bit his hand. Boardman PD officer arrested Dean Laroy Staten, 40, for Assault IV-Domestic Misdemeanor, Menacing, Harassment and Strangulation. He was released on his own recognizance with conditions.

MCSO deputy cited Laurie Gaye Brown, 52, for Violation of the Basic Rule, 77 mph in a 55 mph zone.

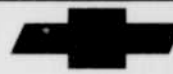
