

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

Sept. 9: Boardman PD received a report of an unwanted male at the front door of the caller's residence. The subject was threatening to kill the caller's mother and advised he had a gun. Juan Jose Garcia Gomez, 26, was arrested for Menacing and Telephonic Harassment. He was lodged at Umatilla County Jail.

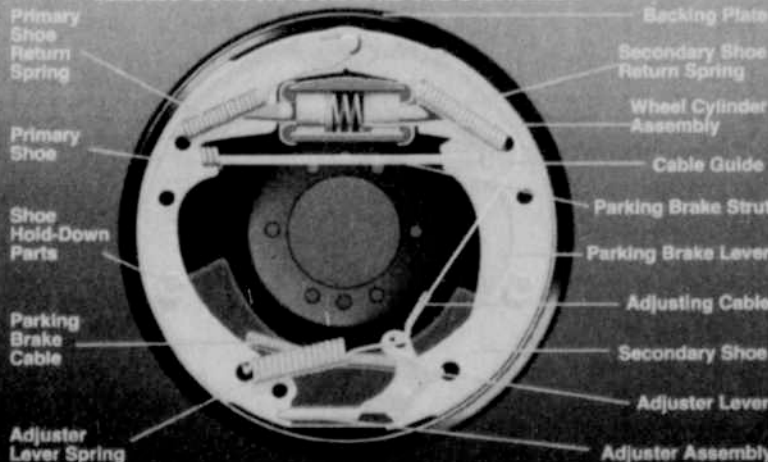
-MCSO received a 911 hang-up call from a location in Irrigon. On call-back the line was open and a child was talking in the background. It was determined the child trying to dial 922.

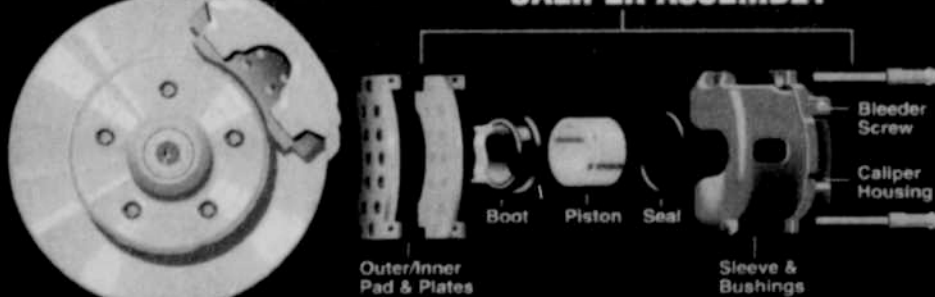
