

### Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

**Oct. 13:** MCSO cited Juan Rojas Cruz, 38, for Driving Uninsured.

-MCSO received a report from a caller in Irrigon stating that three male juveniles were on his property looking for something and they were at the end of his driveway and when he approached them they seemed upset at him for being there. No weapons were visible. There were no altercations between the juveniles and the caller and they had left the area.
