

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

Dec. 5: - MCSO issued a citation to Robert William Stroh, 64, for violating the basic rule by going 74 mph in a 55 mph zone.

-MCSO received a report from a deputy that was out with a suspicious vehicle. The vehicle belonged to a subject working on Bombing Range Rd in Boardman.
