The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

-BPD issued a citation to Sheila Ann Dubry, 31, for going 30 mph in a 20 mph zone and failing to carry proof of insurance.


-BPD received a report hat juveniles at the Marina were calling 911 from the payphone and laughing and hanging up.






