

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

May 19: -MCSO received a report of a possible intoxicated driver eastbound on I-84. MCSO responded.

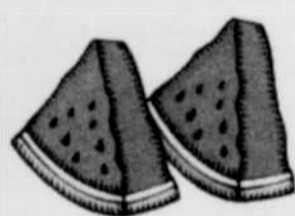
