

**Sheriff's Report**

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

**June 5:** (continued)

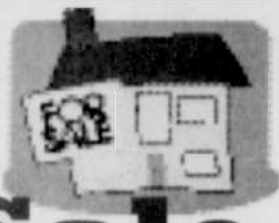
-MCSO deputy advised he was out with a vehicle at the W.C. Reservoir. The people said they were fishing and will stay at the hotel that night.
