Stroke and osteoporosis screenings coming to Heppner

Life Line Screenings will be held in Heppner at St. Patrick's Catholic Church on Wednesday, September 26. Appointments will begin at 11 a.m.

A stroke, also known as a "brain attack," is ranked as the third leading killer in the world, and the leading cause of nursing home admissions. Stroke often occurs without warning. The good news is that painless screening can help identify problems that can lead to stroke before it is too late.

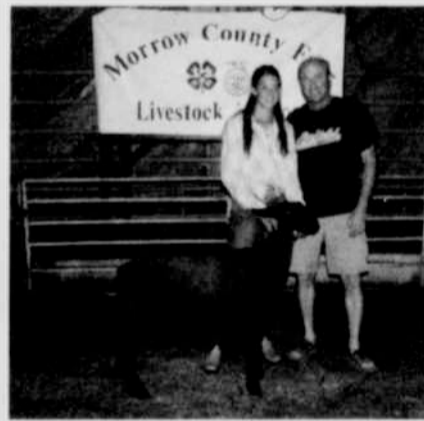

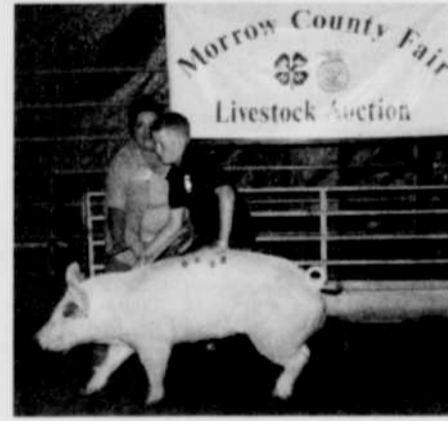
