

PUBLIC NOTICE

And any and all persons interested in any of the real property included in this foreclosure list are required to file answer and defense, if any there be, to such application for judgment within thirty (30) days from the date of the first publication of this notice, which date is, August 27, 2007. Access and Habitat Program to help fund pheasant habitat improvements on private lands

The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's Access and Habitat Program has awarded Columbia Plateau Pheasants Forever and the Morrow County Soil and Water Conservation District a \$145,500 grant to hire a habitat specialist for three years to help landowners improve pheasant and other upland bird habitat on their properties. The habitat specialist is expected to be hired by September.

Morrow County is a major destination for pheasant hunters. However, pheasant populations in Morrow County and surrounding areas have been declining partially due to more efficient farming methods that leave less food and cover behind for pheasants and other upland birds and now result in fewer hunting opportunities.

The habitat specialist will work with landowners in Morrow and Gilliam counties to develop upland bird habitat projects on private lands, provide technical advice as well as assist in obtaining funding, materials, equipment and labor.

Typical projects might include planting grasses, trees and shrubs, weed control, and controlled burns.

"Many landowners are very interested in doing some habitat work on their land if there is someone who can provide technical advice and help with the workload," said Travis Schultz, wildlife technician at the ODFW Heppner District office. "There is a lot of potential for upland bird habitat improvement in Morrow and Gilliam counties."

Several projects have already been lined up and will be implemented once the habitat specialist is hired.

Currently, there are about 124,000 acres of private lands open to public hunting in Morrow and Gilliam counties through the ODFW A&H Program and Upland Cooperative Access Program, so Oregon hunters will see direct benefits as habitat on these lands is improved and pheasant and other upland game bird numbers increase.

The A&H Program is funded by a \$2 surcharge

on hunting licenses. Funds raised by the program are distributed through grants to individual and corporate landowners, conservation organizations and others for cooperative wildlife habitat improvement and hunter access projects throughout the state.
